JESUS CHRIST WILL NOT COME BACK UNTIL ALL THINGS ARE FULFILLED, AND THE FOLLOWING EIGHT (8) THINGS TAKE PLACE:

- 1. His bride has made herself ready without "spot" or "blemish," and she is His overcoming, triumphant militant Church.
- 2. The gospel of the kingdom has been preached in the entire world as a witness to all the nations.
- 3. A remnant according to the election of grace from all twelve (12) tribes of Israel shall be saved.
- 4. Jesus Christ will not return from heaven until the times of restoration of all things which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began is accomplished.
- 5. The "redemption," "restoration," and "reconciliation" of all things, especially concerning all Israel. Both the Jews and former Gentiles becoming the One New Man in the "physical" earthly realm are the two witnesses of the Book of Revelation, spiritually speaking.
- 6. Prior to the "Day of the Lord" God will pour out His Spirit on ALL flesh, so whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. This is based on Joel 2:28–32. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance among the "remnant" that the Lord calls.
- 7. The Orthodox Jews from the House of Judah must hear the gospel concerning Jesus Christ and receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior in order to be saved. They must repent of their "unbelief" and for "rejecting" Him because they did not recognize the hour of His visitation.
- 8. We must "remember" the Law of Moses that the Lord commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, which includes God's everlasting "statutes" and "judgments" before the great and terrible "Day of the Lord." And, we must be endued with power on high with the Spirit of Elijah so we can be His witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea, and Samaria to the ends of the world.

We must worship our heavenly Father both in Spirit according to His truth. This is the only way God's people will walk according to the terms and conditions of the "Covenant of Marriage." In fact, Jesus will be opening the seven seals of the "Ketubah" during the tribulation period. A "Ketubah" is a Jewish prenuptial agreement. It is considered an integral part of a traditional Jewish marriage, and outlines the rights and responsibilities of the groom, in relation to the bride and vice versa. The "consummation" of the wedding during the "marriage supper of the Lamb" cannot take place until Jesus opens the seven (7) seals of this scroll.

Jesus is the only One worthy to open the seven (7) seals of this scroll which are the "terms and conditions" of God's people walking in a "Covenant of Marriage" once we become saved by grace through faith for this reason: Jesus fulfilled (consummated, executed, and ratified [confirmed]) this covenant with His precious blood which was the result of the everlasting covenant God established with Abraham and his descendants.
