- They block property owners from building on their land.
- And they issue crushing fines against property owners, even when there is no proven violation.
- They sneak onto private land looking for violations. And sometimes they even manufacture those violations and then arrest the owners.
- And when they declare an area of the property to be a wetland, true or not, the property owner can no longer use the land, nor sell it.

Most recently, residents of Riverton, Wyoming were shocked to discover that the EPA had literally given their town to an Indian reservation.

How is that possible? An agency of the federal government cannot just decide to give away a whole town and change the border of a state. Only Congress can do that. **Our Federal government is out of control.**

Property rights in America – your right to own and control your own property -- are being destroyed by outlaw agencies like the EPA.

Under Barack Obama, the EPA and the Army Corp of Engineers are making it virtually impossible for land owners to live securely on their own property.

This is a tyranny orchestrated to enforce the policies of Agenda 21 and Sustainable Development.

Whereas: A National Right to Work Act would end the injustice of forced unionism in America once and for all;



Smart meter or alternative meter? You have do have a choice!

FP&L is sending out the below letters to those on their "postpone" list for smart meters and people are confused.

First, as I reported to you in January, the FPSC approved FP&L's tariff to charge a fee for those refusing the smart meter. The fee approved is \$95/upfront and \$13/month. The fee will commence once FP&L's billing system changes are finished, which in the tariff they said was estimated to be April 2014. The Order approving this tariff allows FP&L to charge, even if there is a protest filed, but they must hold the revenues collected "subject to refund" in case they lose the protest. Currently there are 36,000 customers who refused the installation of the smart meter and FP&L estimated in their tariff filing that they anticipate only 12,000 to actually enroll in their opt out program once they charge fees. So they expect about two-thirds to cave or for it to be unaffordable to continue to resist.

Second, there were two protests filings made by citizens against these fees. They are in progress and FP&L has put in a motion to have them dismissed (routine). To the best of my knowledge I don't believe you can be added after the cut-off date. Third, everyone needs to make their own decision on what to do. I have not been notified yet. But once I receive their letter I plan to send FP&L a certified letter and tell them I am enrolling "under duress and protest" and re-iterate that I do NOT CONSENT to this equipment they call a smart meter. Once they start charging, I will pay my bill with two checks. The portion for the opt out fee will be separate and the check will be labeled "Under duress and protest". Please note that FP&L stated in their filings that those not paying the fee will be subject to collection procedures which can cause havoc on your credit ratings. If you do not enroll, my understanding is that they will place a smart meter on your property. If your property is unavailable to them (meter is caged or access is blocked), you will be automatically enrolled in the non-standard meter program and charged the fees.

What you can do:

1. Retain your analog meter. Once they take it, you will never see it again. (Remember you will get an undefined "non-communicating" meter in the future.)

You own the meter enclosure. All the costs and burdens were transferred to you in 1988 at the request of FP&L. See Order # 18893 attached. FP&L only has rights to 1) determine the type of meter enclosure to be used, 2) determine the location of the meter enclosure on your property and 3) place "simply a meter" in your enclosure. The smart meter is much more than a meter (measuring device). You have a choice of meter.

We are writing to advise you that the Florida Public Service Commission has approved Florida Power & Light Company's proposal to offer a Non-Standard Meter Option to eligible customers who prefer not to have a smart meter.

Our records show that you currently have a non-standard meter. If you wish to keep the non-standard meter, you will need to sign up for the Non-Standard Meter Option, which includes additional fees.

Please choose your meter option no later than March 24th, 2014.

Making your choice is easy. Just follow three simple steps:

(1) Know the facts. Smart meters provide important customer benefits and an enhanced level of service at no additional charge. They provide you with more information to help you manage your electricity use and bills, and they help us prevent power outages and get the lights back on faster if outages do occur. That is why they are now the standard meter FPL provides.

(2) Compare the costs and benefits. The benefits of smart meters are not available with non-standard meters. In addition, if you choose the Non-Standard Meter Option, you will pay an enrollment fee of \$95 and a monthly surcharge of \$13 to help cover FPL's costs of providing this non-standard service. Action/Prayer/FYI Item #5:

Florida's state legislative session began on Tuesday, March 4th. Here are five bills to watch for.

1. Concealed weapons (SB 544, HB 523): Floridians could apply for concealed weapons permits at county tax collectors' offices where they renew their vehicle tags to ease the growing backlog of applications, but it would cost more. Likely to pass.
2. Flood insurance (SB 542, HB 581): To address the crisis in flood insurance, private insurers would be encouraged to market policies to homeowners, but costs have not been fully addressed. Passage uncertain.
3. Inmate IDs (SB 274, HB 53): Every inmate released from a state prison would be given a state-issued ID to help them re-enter society and seek a job. Likely to pass.
4. Speed limits (SB 392): Motorists on rural interstate highways where the speed limit is now 70 mph could go 75 mph. Passage uncertain.
5. Tanning salons (SB 572, HB 499): Minors would be prohibited from using tanning salons because of skin cancer risks. Unlikely to pass.

SHORT TITLE A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF POMPANO BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION 100 RESILIENT CITIES CENTENNIAL CHALLENGE GRANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF HIRING A CHIEF RESILIENCE OFFICER WHO WILL DEVELOP A RESILIENCY PLAN FOR THE CITY; AND IF AWARDED, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE FUNDS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. NO MATCH REQUIRED.

Summary of Purpose and Why:

The City of Pompano Beach is preparing to submit a grant proposal for the Rockefeller Foundation 100 Resilient Cities Centennial Challenge. The Rockefeller Foundation has launched a challenge and a call to cities to apply for a chance to be included in a global network of resiliency. The Foundation will select 100 cities and provide assistance of 100 million dollars (divided between the cities selected) to support the cities in hiring 'Chief Resilience Officers' and creating a global information-sharing network.

Pompano Beach proposes to recruit and hire a Chief Resilience Officer that will develop a Resiliency Plan to address the five most pressing issues specific to the City. The position will be funded by the grant for two years. While employed, the Chief Resilience Officer will develop a Resiliency Plan that City Staff can then implement. This plan will help to satisfy the Superior Capacity Strategy of the City's Strategic Plan by addressing ocean rise (Operational Goals and Initiatives 8.0), assist in fulfilling the Coastal Zone Management Element of the Comprehensive Plan, and enhance the Broward County Enhanced Local Mitigation Strategy.

A copy of the grant application is enclosed. There is no financial contribution from the City required as part of this grant proposal.
