

THREE DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS DOES NOT EQUATE TO JESUS BEING RESURRECTED ON SUNDAY MORNING

On that particular Passover over 2,000 years ago Jesus died in the middle of the week on a Wednesday. A small child counting on their fingers can figure out that if Jesus died on Good Friday and He was in the grave for three “days” and three “nights” which is based on Matthew 12:40, He would NOT have risen from the grave on Sunday morning. Yet we have gone along with this deception and have brought it into the body of Christ.

If this is not bad enough, our religious leaders have presented this lie to the entire world as God’s truth as they delightfully fill the pews of their churches on “Easter Sunday.”

The Lord says, “Enough with this apostasy My people!”

It was during the Feast of Unleavened Bread Jesus was buried in the tomb, and He was resurrected three “days” and three “nights” later from the heart of the earth based on Matthew 12:38–42.

This was the “sign” Jesus said He would give to an evil and adulterous generation who seeks after a “sign,” and no “sign” would be given to it except the “sign” of the prophet Jonah which would prove He is indeed our Messiah. Yet Christendom “erroneously” proclaims Jesus died on Good Friday and was resurrected two days later on Sunday the first day of the week. This is impossible based on the fact we are specifically told Jesus would be in the heart of the earth for a full three “days” and three “nights” which proves this is a false teaching.

Let me ask you a question. When was Jesus crucified, resurrected, and ascended into heaven where He is now seated at the right hand of our heavenly Father?

The answer is over two thousand years ago at Passover is when Jesus was crucified. On that particular Passover, Jesus died on a Wednesday. He did not die on Friday, especially not on “Good Friday.”

He was in the heart of the earth for three “days” and three “nights” during the Feast of Unleavened Bread. He was “resurrected” on the “third” day at twilight on the weekly seventh (7th) day Sabbath.

And, He was the firstfruits of the dead when He ascended into heaven on Sunday, the first day of the week.

He ascended up to heaven the day after the weekly seventh day Sabbath during the Feast of Firstfruits. He was offered to God, the Father, as a firstfruits wave offering of all the

firstfruits of the dead of those who are Christ's at His second coming (1 Corinthians 15:23).

Then fifty days later He poured out His Spirit during the Feast of Weeks (Shavuot or Pentecost).

All these holy convocations I just listed are our heavenly Father's spring/early summer feasts which are detailed in Leviticus Chapter 23.

Yet you will not find Easter in the Bible because God did not command us to commemorate Easter. Rather, He told us to keep Passover. Again, the Roman Catholic Church invented Easter. Easter is NOT about our Passover Lamb at all. Passover is mentioned 27 times in the New Testament; Easter is never mentioned because the Roman Catholic Church instituted Easter as they laid aside the commandments of God. Since the Church follows the commandments of the apostle Paul more than what our heavenly Father said or Jesus said, why do we conveniently overlook the fact Paul told us to keep this feast?

God's people are supposed to stand for the truth. So why aren't we? Especially, since Jesus said to do "this" in remembrance of Him. If we do not take a stand on God's truth, then we have nothing to stand on. Who is willing to take a stand for His truth? But the hour is coming, and NOW is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in SPIRIT and TRUTH; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

Is Jesus (Yeshua) our perfect Passover Lamb worthy or not? We must decide today "which" God we shall serve. If you want to worship Baal, then go ahead. But please do not profane our Savior's "priceless" sacrifice on the cross at Calvary and celebrate Easter a pagan,
