WHEN GOD COMMANDS US TO "REMEMBER" SOMETHING, WE WOULD BE WISE TO DO SO

Those who **transgress** God's laws, **change** His ordinances (i.e., His seven holy convocations listed in Leviticus 23 which begins with the seventh [7th] day Sabbath), and have **broken** His *everlasting* covenant He established with Abraham will be "consumed" and "destroyed" at the brightness of Jesus' second coming (Isaiah 24:4-6).

This is why we are told in Malachi 4:4-5 to "remember" the Law of Moses, with the statutes and judgments, before the great and terrible "Day of the Lord."

The word "remember" is Strong's #H2142 and is the Hebrew word "zakar" (pronounced "zaw-kar'"), which means: To mark (so as to be recognized).

God will "mark well" with His Mark of Authority (His signet ring-the seal of righteousness and genuineness) those who "remember" the Law of Moses and those who "remember" the Sabbath day (the 7th day) to keep it holy.

The seventh (7th) day Sabbath is the only commandment in the Ten Commandments God tells us to "remember." Exodus 20:8: "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy." And, this commandment to keep the seventh (7th) day Sabbath is reiterated in the New Testament under the New Covenant. In this short teaching, I will prove this fact beyond a shadow of a doubt.

Yet most in Christendom "erroneously" proclaim this is the only commandment of the Ten Commandments that no longer applies to New Covenant believers which is a "fatal" mistake for this reason: God's Sabbaths are a "sign" (mark or evidence) He is the Creator of the heavens and the earth. Thus, He is the Lord of the Sabbath and we are His "covenant" people if we "obey" His commandments (especially the BIG TEN) AFTER we become saved by grace through faith in Jesus (Yeshua).

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Yahweh (YHWH) instituted the seventh (7th) day Sabbath during the creation week before there was a distinction between either Jew or Gentile and we are commanded to keep it in the New Testament under the New Covenant.

So, why aren't we? It is because we have been led astray and deceived. There is something seriously wrong when we claim all the Ten Commandments are still applicable to New Covenant believers EXCEPT the only one God told us to "remember"–the 4th commandment which specifically tells us the specific "day" we are to keep the Sabbath Day on which is the seventh (7th) day, not Sunday the first (1st) day of the week.

Again, the Roman Catholic Church changed God's Sabbath Day to Sunday the first day of the week because they claim the following:

- 1. Sunday is their Mark of Authority.
- 2. Their authority is ABOVE the Word of God.

I have done extensive research on this fact. Take the time to read this article which substantiates what I am saying is true.

Yet we are clearly told in God's "eternal" Word, which does not change, that the seventh (7th) day Sabbath is His Mark of Authority.

Hence, many in the body of Christ are worshiping the Lord God in vain. It is not a coincidence the 3rd commandment of the Ten Commandments comes right before the 4th commandment.

The 3rd commandment is Exodus 20:7, which says, "You SHALL not TAKE the NAME of the LORD YOUR GOD in <u>VAIN</u> [H7723: shav: in the sense of desolating; evil (as destructive), literally (ruin) or morally (especially guile); figuratively idolatry (as false,

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subjectively), uselessness (as deceptive); false, lie, lying], for the Lord will not HOLD HIM GUILTLESS who takes HIS NAME in VAIN." (NKJV) (emphasis added).

When we "worship" and "serve" the Lord according to what we deem right in our own eyes we are exalting our "opinions" above the Word of God. Remember the Gold Calf? The children of Israel thought they were worshiping the Lord but they did it in a manner that was unacceptable in His sight. Read what happened as a result. This story is found in Exodus Chapter 32. About 3,000 people perished that day.

However, I want to focus your attention on Exodus 32:33-34 which says, "And the Lord said to Moses, 'Whoever has SINNED against Me, I will BLOT him out of MY BOOK.. Now therefore, go, lead the people to the place of which I have spoken to you. Behold, My Angel shall go before you. Nevertheless, in the day [Judgment Day] when I visit for punishment, I will visit punishment upon them for their sin." (NKJV) (emphasis added).

We will have to give an account to the Holy One of Israel on Judgment Day as to why we blatantly did not "obey" His commandments even though we "claimed" to worship Him.

In fact, the apostle Paul substantiates what I am WARNING you about ahead of time when he says in 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9, "...in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not OBEY the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. these shall be punished with EVERLASTING DESTRUCTION from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power..." (NKJV) (emphasis added).

Thus, there are "eternal" consequences for those who practice "lawlessness." Jesus tells WARNS us ahead of time in Matthew 7:21–23, concerning those who do not do the "will" of our heavenly Father by obeying His commandments, Jesus will say to them on Judgment Day, the following:

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but HE WHO DOES THE WILL OF MY FATHER IN HEAVEN. Many will say to Me in that day [Judgment Day], 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' Based on what Jesus says to us in Matthew 7:21–23, do not dismiss this critical truth: The very ones to whom Jesus will say to depart from Him when it is too late for all eternity to repent and make a course correction because He never "knew" them is for this reason: They "practiced" lawlessness, and did not do the "will" of His heavenly Father. They did not "obey" His heavenly Father's instructions written in the Torah.

Thus, they are using His name in VAIN. They are prophesying in His name, casting out demons in His name, doing many wonders in His name—but they are practicing "lawlessness" and not doing the "will" of His heavenly Father.

Hence, Jesus will "blot out" their name from the Lamb's Book of Life, and it will be as though they have never been born or "reborn" again, *spiritually* speaking.

So, if Jesus tells us to "depart" from Him on Judgment Day and He says He never "knew" us because we practice "lawlessness" and did not do the "will" of our heavenly Father, is this a salvation issue? Yes, it is.

We are in the valley of decision. Decide this day "which" God you are truly worshiping.
